





1914-1926

The King's Badge (1914) and National Service (1915) badges were worn on the left arm.





1926—1946

During the war years the badges were manufactured to the Utility Regulations, without the fretting and frosted finish.





1946—1968

The Duke of Edinburgh's Awards were introduced in 1958, and are the only badges still in current use.








#### 1984-2007



This awards series was used in conjunction with a system of foil credits in the Boys handbook.





#### 1968-1984



After 1976 these were manufactured in gold plastic, with a colour sticker, and sometimes worn in conjunction with the bronze anodized badges.







2007—Present

The re-design of the Awards scheme in 2007, retained the Queen's and President's badges introduced in 1994.
