Here is a chance for all members of The Boys' Brigade in Scotland to take part in a special appeal to mark the Centenary of the Brigade to obtain "VENTILATORS" which will be used to help save the lives of infants.

There are many different categories of infants and children who will benefit from your generosity. For example, babies born prematurely frequently require help

from a ventilator during the first few days or weeks of life until their own lungs are mature enough to enable them to breathe air normally. As do children who have been involved in road accidents, children who suffer from lung disorders and children who are undergoing operations.

Each "VENTILATOR" will cost about £5,000 and we hope to present one to each Royal Hospital for Sick Children in Glasgow, Edinburgh and Aberdeen and possibly to other Hospitals depending on the success of the Appeal.

The Appeal is directed very much to the Boys and Officers of the Brigade and it is hoped you will save 10 x 10p of your own money (£1 in total) in the collecting sleeves although we know only too well that parents and close friends may wish to contribute. With nearly 60,000 members of the Brigade in Scotland the initial target of £15,000 should not be too difficult a task.
