GLASGOW ⇄ EUSTON ⇄ ALBERT HALL ⇄ GLASGOW

In celebration of the Brigade's Centenary in 1983, Glasgow Battalion is organising a **Centenary Special** to London on Saturday 14 May 1983. British Rail will provide a charter train to transport 700 Boys' Brigade members, friends and relatives on this day outing from Glasgow Central to London Euston with the additional attraction of attending the London District Boys' Brigade Centenary Display in the Royal Albert Hall. It is the intention of British Rail that this excursion train will be hauled by the Class 86 Locomotive to be named "**The Boys' Brigade**"—at a ceremony in Glasgow Central on Saturday 9 April 1983.

The **Centenary Special** departure time from Glasgow Central will be early Saturday morning around 7.30 am returning at approximately 7.00 pm from London Euston to arrive in Glasgow after

11.00 pm. Confirmation of these departure times will be given when tickets are distributed.

The Centenary Display of the London District takes place at 3.00pm in the Royal Albert Hall. There will be ample time in London to attend this afternoon performance and seats can be reserved in the Stalls area. Transportation between London Euston and the Royal Albert Hall will be at the discretion of each individual and these travelling costs are not included in the package price. The Battalion will be happy to accommodate individuals wishing to travel to London for the excursion only without attending the London District Display. Considerable interest has already been aroused in support of **Centenary Special** and early ticket application is advisable.
