



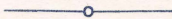

Saturday, 6th September, 1958*

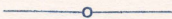

The following points are given as reminders :

- Navy blue suit.
- Double stiff white collar — white shirt.
- Plain black tie.
- No tie-pin.
- No handkerchief, fountain pen or pencil in breast pocket.
- Black shoes and socks.
- Tan gloves worn.
- Lapel badges unpolished.
- Cap badge polished — no red rosettes permissible.
- Jacket fully buttoned.
- Only Ribbons of medals and decorations will be worn.
- Council Meeting lapel badge will not be worn.
