Remember

— you need to book your Activities with your clan Executive Officer two days in advance, and your first choice of activity may not always be available when you want it.

When you complete an activity ask the Officer in charge of your Group to initial your record card for the appropriate activity.

When you have collected all the points you need, hand your card to the Central Activities Staff who will check it over and give you your Camp Award, which you can stitch on to your Camp Sweatshirt.
