

CENTENARY INTERNATIONAL CAMP SCONE PALACE 20th-30th August 1983.



The historic setting of Scone Palace will be home to 2,000 BB Boys and Officers between 20th - 30th August 1983. They will be coming from all over the world to take part in The Boys' Brigade Centenary Celebrations.

The BB was the first youth organisation to go camping seriously and it has contributed in no small measure to the wide spread development of this form of holiday. The first camp, by the 1st Glasgow Company, at Tighnabruach in 1886 set the pattern,

although modern programmes have been adjusted (6.30 a.m. Reveille or Company Drill before breakfast are not so popular nowadays!)

All boys attending the camp will have the opportunity to experience a fellowship second to none. As with all BB camps there will be a chance to take part in a wide range of activities, some of which are listed below.
