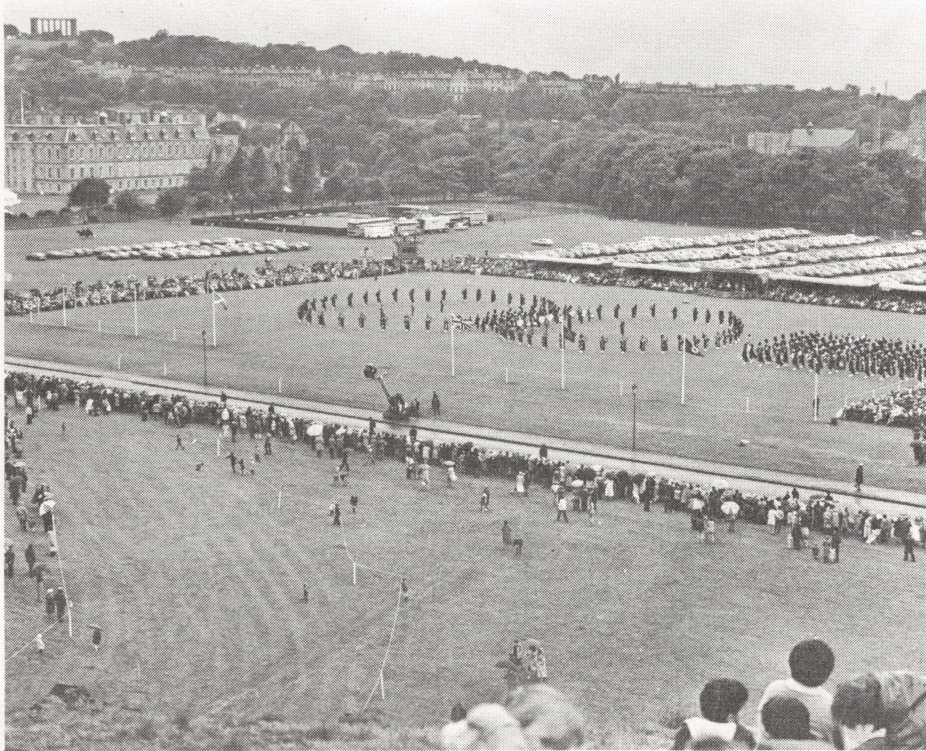

HER MAJESTY REVIEWS THE BRIGADE

One of the major highlights of the Brigade's Centenary Year will take place at Holyrood Park, Edinburgh, on Saturday, July 2, 1983.

On that day, Our Patron, Her Majesty The Queen, will review The Boys' Brigade.

Officers and Boys from every District in the United Kingdom and the Republic of Ireland will be on parade. All Boys must be at least 14 years of age and priority will be given to Queen's Men. Strict observance of Uniform regulations will be enforced. Music will be provided by Pipes and Drums, Bugle and Brass Bands.

PARADE GROUND

The Parade Ground at Holyrood Park has been the scene of many momentous occasions over the years. It is ideally suited for such occasions with its enormous capacity for many thousands of spectators.

To the North of the Parade Ground is the Royal Enclosure and seated accommodation for specially invited guests. To the East and West of the Square there will be reserved seats for those wishing to purchase tickets (Price £1.50).

Application for seats should be made by not later than May 9, 1983. As it is anticipated that the demand will be considerable, seats will be

allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. Cheques should accompany requests.

SPECTATOR AREAS

For those unable to obtain tickets there are huge areas to the South where more than 20,000 people can take up vantage points on the grassy slopes of Arthur's Seat. The picture above was taken from one such vantage point.

Officers, Boys, parents and friends of the Brigade who come to Edinburgh on July 2, will be assured of an excellent view of the proceedings. They will feel part of this historic and momentous occasion in the history of the Boys' Brigade.
