GETTING INTO THE ACTIVITY

Jesus wants us to 'shine our light' for all to see - just like a lighthouse. But what does that mean?

What do you use a lamp or a torch for? To light up darkness, to see the way and to help guide you.

Jesus tells a story in the bible that encourages people to shine like bright lights to help others, reflect God's love and make the world a better place. (Matthew 5:14-16). God wants us to be like bright lighthouses, shining God's light for miles around so everyone can see it and know God's love. Just by being good people, helping others and living a life that pleases God, we are already helping to shine a light for others to see. Our job is to carry on doing that.

Help yourself to remember that we should be shining light all around, by creating a lighthouse. You could make one out of craft materials (kitchen roll tube, plastic cup), build one from Lego or draw one using colouring pens.
