DRESS. Mufti. (Ribbons of Orders and Medals should be worn by those entitled to them.)

TIME. An Announcement will be made by loud speaker, and Old Boys are asked to proceed immediately to the Parade Ground.

PARADE GROUND. The Car Park below the Main Terrace, immediately behind the Royal Tunnel.

METHOD. Poles will be placed at the head of Battalion Parade Grounds bearing the name of your Battalion.
Fall in by Companies in Threes, the leading Three immediately behind the Pole bearing your Battalion designation.

Old Boys who are Brigade Officers will be formed as a Company at head of each Battalion.

Companies having large contingents of Old Boys will supply one Officer to command the Company.

Information may be obtained from anyone bearing a red armband.

At the conclusion of the Closing Service remain in your places until the Boys have marched out of the Arena. (You will be dismissed within the Arena.)

It is strongly recommended that your friends who are among the spectators should remain in their seats until you are able to rejoin them.
