MEMO TO CAPTAINS OF COMPANIES.

THE BOYS' JUBILEE CAMP.

The Boys' JUBILEE CAMP—which two Boys from every Company are eligible to attend—will be open from FRIDAY MORNING, 8th SEPTEMBER, until WEDNESDAY MORNING, 13th SEPTEMBER, 1933.

The Brigade will bear a considerable proportion of the cost of this great Camp. For Boys attending, there will be a modified charge of 15/- per Boy for 4 days and 3 nights, with an extra 4/6 for each additional night. These charges include all transport while in Glasgow, in addition to meals, entertainments, and the Excursion on the Monday.

Boys need only bring their own personal kit. Bedding, blankets, and crockery will be provided.

Only Boys of 15 B.B. age or over in Session 1932-3 may attend, and it is recommended that in choosing Boys, preference should be given to those likely to continue their B.B. service in future. A further Form asking for names and Camp Fees will be issued next Session.

In the meantime, in order to enable preliminary arrangements to be made, it is requested that the attached form should be returned within the next few weeks, and in any case *not later* than 31st MAY, 1932.
