#### END OF SECTION ONE

Bands move off at 2 minute-15 seconds intervals, some paired to give best effect and to keep overall timing to the minimum.

60 separate bands playing as 51 units in 32 sections. 1 nour-10 minutes overall time. 2.30 p.m. to 3.40 p.m.

Inspection of Drum Majors by H.R.H. the Duke of Gloucester between 2.00 p.m. - 2.25 p.m.

All the above bands to be formed up on Horseguards Parade on right of Central Avenue looking towards Horseguards Parade on right of Central Avenue looking towards Horseguards Arch (side nearer Downing Street) (see positions on accompanying plan).

All Drum Majors

to form up for Inspection forward of all bands to Central Avenue.

Bands marked 'L' (for Left) and 'k' (for Right) will move off together, the Right band taking the lead until the Mall, when both bands take up the position abreast of each other, taking the full width of the very wide road. It is suggested that each Band play alternately with one Drum Raffle between. The other Band keeps the exact pace with the tap whilst the other is playing.

when the Bands come up to the Saluting Base at the Victoria Memorial, the Right-hand band takes the lead again with the Left falling immediately behind. Whichever band is playing during the actual salute, continue whilst the Drum Major and Officers only salute.

#### THERE WILL BE NO SLOW MARCHING OR STOPPING BEFORE THE SALUTING BASE.

The Band keeping pace will all carry out, on the order of the Drum Major, a full Eyes Left Salute.

Immediately on reaching the other side of the Victoria Memorial, both bands will STOP PLAYING and march to the tap only until reaching Birdcage Walk. This is to allow the following band to perform for the Salute. (If you check with the map, you will understand the reason.)
