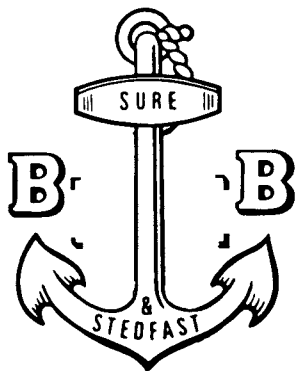


This was the emblem when The Boy's Brigade started in 1883. At that time it was the first uniformed organisation for Boys and from it grew all the other youth organisations.

What is different about the emblem and the emblem we have today in The Boys' Brigade?

### THE BOYS' BRIGADE EMBLEM AS WE KNOW IT TODAY

Join the crosses to show the emblem of The Boys' Brigade as we know it today. This should be done in red and coloured in completely.



What you have just added was first added to the BB Anchor on 1 October 1926 when The Boys' Life Brigade united with The Boys' Brigade. The Boys' Life Brigade had an emblem of a Red Cross and their motto was "To Save Life".

Note that the anchor is placed on top of the red cross and The Boys' Brigade motto was the motto that continued after the union.

### THE BOYS' BRIGADE OBJECT:

Many things in The Boys' Brigade have changed over the years but one thing that has changed little from the time that William Alexander Smith started the Movement is the BB Object. This is the aim and whole reason for The Boys' Brigade Movement existing. The Object then was:

"The Advancement of Christ's Kingdom among Boys, and the promotion of habits of Reverence, Discipline, Self-Respect, and all that tends towards a true Christian Manliness".

Later the word 'Obedience' was added, and you should learn this Object by heart because it is and always has been the real strength of The Boys' Brigade. Many men have achieved true Christian Manliness by following the BB Object all the days of their lives and most can remember it, word perfect, years after leaving. It is one of the first things that you learn in The Boys' Brigade and the last thing you forget.

Remember not looking up the page for the answer.

"The Advancement of C — — — — — Kingdom among B — — — — — and the P — — — — —  
of habits of O — — — — —, R — — — — —, D — — — — —  
Self-Respect, and all that tends T — — — — — a true C — — — — —  
M — — — — —."

To help you remember the Object write it out on a piece of cardboard, then cut the cardboard up into a jig-saw which you then have to put together again. You will see below how to space out the words on the piece of card before you cut it up. Do not make the pieces too small.

Another way to help you remember it when you think that you know it, is to write the Object out on a piece of paper or cardboard. Then cut each individual word out, jumble them up and then rearrange them properly to state the Object.

## THE UNIFORM

The Boys' Brigade was the first uniformed organisation for young people. All of the others — The Girls' Brigade, Scouts, Girl Guides and even the Youth Clubs have grown out of the idea of The Boys' Brigade.

We wear uniform for many reasons, eg.,

- a) to show that we BELONG to The Boys' Brigade.
  - b) so that we all LOOK the same, part of the team.
- Just like a football team wears the same strip.

There is no point in wearing a uniform if it is not worn *correctly*, because The Boys' Brigade is judged by the appearance of its members. There are two types of uniform which can be worn by Boys. Which one does your Company wear?

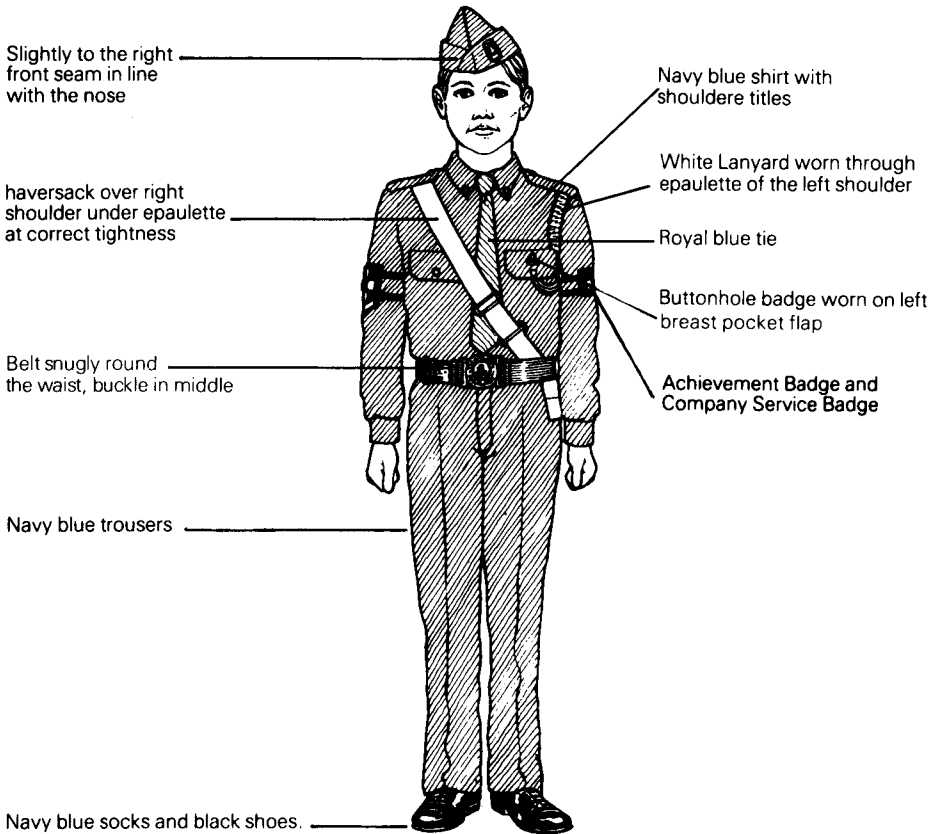
You will see them on these two pages.

When you wear your uniform, you want to look smart and let people see that you are a member of the best Boys' Organisation in the world.

#### 'B' Uniform

Slightly to the right front seam in line with the nose

Black tie

Haversack over right shoulder at correct tightness

Runners as far apart as possible

Belt snugly round the waist

Buckle in the middle

White shirt

Buttonhole Badge

Achievement Badge and Company Service Badge

Dark blue or black jacket

Haversack pouch — The front should be in line with the front of the pocket.

Dark Trousers

Navy Blue Socks

Black Shoes

### WEARING THE BB HAT

The flaps cross over the front. The hat is not worn square. Angle it slightly on the right of the head. Tap down the crown (centre) of the hat to get a dipped effect. Front seam in line with nose. When viewed from the side, the base of the hat should be horizontal.

### CLEANING YOUR UNIFORM

Uniform must be cleaned for EVERY Parade. here are a few tips: —

1. Hat — brushed free of all dust.
2. Jacket — brushed.
3. Trousers — well pressed (see Mother).
4. Shoes — polished.
5. Haversack — (a) Must be well washed, starched and ironed (see Mother).  
(b) Brass slides and buttons must be polished.  
To polish the button, first remove it from the haversack.  
Polishing the slides is more difficult since they cannot be removed.
  1. Take a piece of card (paper is too thin) and cut it the width of the haversack and about 20cm long.
  2. Slide the card between the haversack and the buckle so that the white haversack is covered by the card.
  3. Put on the metal polish (Duraglit or Brasso) very *carefully* (or it will have to be washed again) and let it dry.
  4. Rub off the dry polish with a soft cloth.
  5. Carefully remove the card.
- 6 Badges — do not need to be polished.
- 7 Belt — (a) The buckles and slides are polished the same way as the haversack. However, if the belt is new it is difficult to get a good polish and takes time, but work at it. One tip to clean your buckle is to put the Brasso on with a toothbrush and then rub it very hard. You then polish it with a soft cloth and your washed toothbrush can again be used to clean out the crevices on the buckle. Ask your NCO to help if necessary.  
(b) The leather — must be polished *every week* or the leather will crack. BB Belts are still made of real leather which is why they are expensive.
  1. Put some polish on a cloth, any brown shoe polish will do or even furniture cream.
  2. Rub the polish *hard* into the leather
  3. When it has dried, again rub hard with a soft cloth or brush.

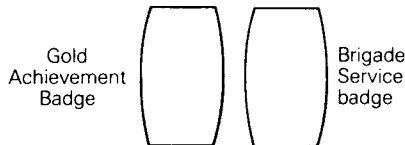

### UNIFORM AND BADGES

Badges are also part of your uniform. If you have given satisfactory service in the Junior Section you should now have your Brigade Service Badge. You may also have your Gold Achievement Badge if you reached Gold standard in the Achievement Scheme.

How should you wear these Badges?

On an armband (see your Company Captain) on your LEFT arm as shown below:



When you have completed Target Award you will be working for other Awards and details of these and how they should be worn are given on pages 28 and 29 of your Boys' Handbook

#### Hat badge Surround

- Junior Section — Yellow
- Company Section — Red
- Seniors — Blue

Boys aged between 15 and 18 years should wear a blue surround to their hat badge. They are called - S — — — — — and must be 15 years of age.

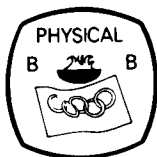

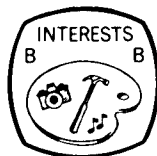

# SIR WILLIAM ALEXANDER SMITH



**No. 1.** This story is a brief look into the work and life of Sir William Alexander Smith, Founder of The Boys' Brigade. A man who to this day is held in the highest honour by the great company of men and Boys serving in the Movement which he founded over 90 years ago. Quiet in manner and speech; the influence he wielded over others was one of his most notable qualities. The founder's life covered a period of sixty years, one half of which he devoted entirely to his Boys' Brigade work.

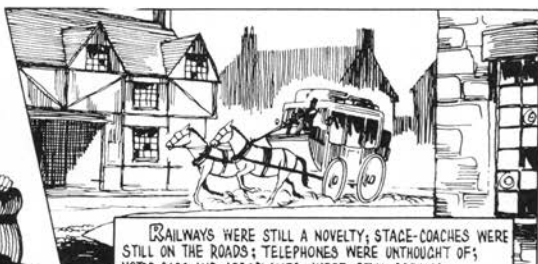
The year 1854 is one of significance to all associated with The Boys' Brigade; for in that year the Founder of this great organisation was born.

THESE WERE DAYS OF HARDSHIP FOR MANY: FOR ALONGSIDE WEALTH WAS EXTREME POVERTY AND MISERY. CHILDREN WORKED LONG HOURS IN CRUEL AND SQUALID FACTORIES; ILL-CLAD AND OFTEN HUNGRY.



CHIMNEY SWEEPS STILL USED BOYS IN PLACE OF SWEEPS' BROOMS.

QUEEN VICTORIA HAD BEEN ON THE THRONE FOR SEVENTEEN OF HER SIXTY-FOUR YEARS. SHE WAS TO REIGN



RAILWAYS WERE STILL A NOVELTY; STAGE-COACHES WERE STILL ON THE ROADS; TELEPHONES WERE UNTHOUGHT OF; MOTOR-CARS AND AERoplanES WERE STILL DREAMS.

AGAINST THIS VICTORIAN BACK-CLOTH, WILLIAM ALEXANDER SMITH WAS BORN ON 27th OCTOBER 1854 AT THURSO, A SMALL GRANITE BUILT COUNTRY TOWN ON THE NORTHERN COAST OF SCOTLAND



THE OLDEST OF FOUR CHILDREN, HIS PARENTS WERE DEYOUT AND GOD-FEARING PEOPLE WHO ATTENDED THE VILLAGE CHURCH REGULARLY.

# FOUNDER OF THE BOYS' BRIGADE



FAMILY PRAYERS WERE CONDUCTED AT HOME AND FROM THERE WILLIAM SMITH WAS TO ACQUIRE HIS LIFE-LONG HABIT OF PRAYER AND BIBLE STUDY.



AT THE AGE OF THIRTEEN, TRAGEDY BEFELL WILLIAM IN THE SUDDEN LOSS OF HIS FATHER, WHO DIED WHILE ON A BUSINESS TRIP TO CHINA.



HIS MOTHER LEFT WITH THE CARE OF THREE BOYS AND ONE GIRL. DISPOSED OF THEIR HOME, PENNYLANG, HOUSE AND WILLIAM WAS SENT TO THE CARE OF HIS UNCLE, ALEXANDER FRASER, A WHOLESALE MERCHANT IN GLASGOW.



FAIR FROM THE NORTHERN SHORES OF SCOTLAND TO THE HURLY-BURLY OF CITY LIFE IN GLASGOW, YOUNG SMITH SOON SETTLED DOWN AND CONTINUED HIS STUDIES, COLLECTING SEVEN PRIZES IN HIS FINAL TERM BEFORE LEAVING SCHOOL.



WITH FEW EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES OPEN TO BOYS, SMITH ENTERED HIS UNCLE'S BUSINESS AND SETTLED DOWN TO THE ROUTINE OF A COMMERCIAL LIFE IN THE CITY.



IT WAS AT THIS TIME THAT SMITH ACQUIRED THE LIFE LONG HABIT OF BURNING THE MIDNIGHT OIL. IN ORDER TO EXTEND HIS HORIZONS, HE SPENT HOURS OF STUDY AFTER WORK; TAKING THE ONLY PATH OPEN TO HIM TO FURTHER HIS EDUCATION.

FROM HIS ARRIVAL IN GLASGOW HE ATTENDED AND LATER BECAME A MEMBER OF THE FREE COLLEGE CHURCH, UNDER THE MINISTRY OF THE REV. GEORGE REITH; THE FATHER OF LORD REITH OF BROADCASTING FAME.



IT WAS AT THIS CHURCH THAT THE 1ST GLASGOW COMPANY WAS LATER TO BE LAUNCHED: THE HAND OF PROVIDENCE WAS ALREADY MARKING OUT FOR HIM THE COURSE OF HIS HIGH DESTINY.



## TARGET TWO



**No. 2.** At the age of thirteen tragedy had befallen William with the death of his father. He left his birthplace at Thurso on the northern coast of Scotland and went to the care of his uncle Alexander Fraser a merchant in Glasgow.

Smith attended the Free College Church in Glasgow and it was from this Church that the Founders life work was to blossom in the years ahead.

YOUNG SMITHS LONGING FOR A SOLDIERS LIFE WAS BORN OF THE SPIRIT OF ADVENTURE AND FAMILY TRADITIONS IN THE HIGHLAND REGIMENTS. DURING HIS EARLY DAYS IN GLASGOW IT SEEMED NATURAL FOR HIM TO JOIN THE 1ST LANARK RIFLE VOLUNTEERS.



IT WAS THE BEGINNING FOR HIM OF A LONG SERVICE IN THAT REGIMENT IN 1914 IT WAS ONE OF THE FIRST TERRITORIAL BATTALIONS TO GO INTO ACTION, UNDER THE NAME OF THE 5th CAMERONIANS (SCOTTISH RIFLES) AND WITH IT WAS LIEUTENANT STANLEY SMITH, THE FOUNDERS ELDEST SON



SMITH ALSO JOINED THE LOCAL Y.M.C.A AND BECAME AN ACTIVE CHURCH WORKER UNDER THE GUIDANCE OF THE REV REITH HIS PATH WAS ALREADY BEING DIRECTED TOWARDS THE TWIN PILLARS OF RELIGION AND DISCIPLINE



GRADUALLY SMITH BECAME INVOLVED WITH THE BOY FOR THE FIRST TIME WHEN HE WAS INTRODUCED TO THE NORTH WOODSIDE SUNDAY SCHOOL, A MISSION SCHOOL OF WHICH THE FREE COLLEGE CHURCH WAS THE PARENT BODY. DURING THESE DAYS, IN ANY OF THE GREAT CITIES, SUNDAY SCHOOLS WERE A HOTBED OF DISORDERS, PATRONISED BY ROUGH BOYS WITH PURELY AGGRESSIVE MOTIVES AND NORTH WOODSIDE WAS NO EXCEPTION.

HIS STRENGTH OF CHARACTER DEVELOPED FAST AND SOON HE HAD LEFT HIS UNCLE'S EMPLOYMENT AND LAUNCHED OUT IN BUSINESS WITH HIS YOUNGER BROTHER IN THE WORLD OF COMMERCE AS SMITH, SMITH & CO.



## TARGET TWO



BY THIS TIME SMITH HAD RECEIVED THE QUEENS COMMISSION IN THE 1ST LANARK RIFLES AND HE SOON RECOGNISED THE VIRTUES OF A SOLDIER'S LIFE. THE RIOT AND TURMOIL THAT NOW FACED HIM IN THE SUNDAY SCHOOL WOULD HAVE TURNED MANY A MAN AWAY. BUT SMITH, CAME, HE SAW AND AFTER DUE THOUGHT AND PREPARATION HE CONQUERED.

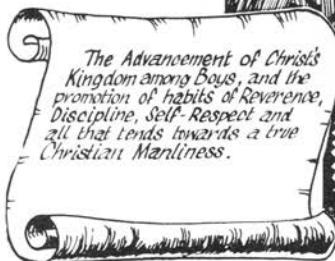
THE ROUGH BOYS WERE SOON LISTENING TO THEIR NEW MASTER WITH RESPECT, FRIENDSHIP AND HERO WORSHIP. BESIDES THIS TALENT FOR MANAGING BOYS, SMITH HAD A SIMILAR APTITUDE FOR DEALING WITH HIS FELLOW MEN.



LATER SMITH BECAME VERY DISTRESSED AT THE NUMBER OF EX-MEMBERS OF HIS SUNDAY SCHOOL, SLOUCHING THROUGH THE STREETS AND CANZING IN CORNERS. HE BECAME DISTRESSED AT THE WASTAGE OF GOOD MATERIAL GOING TO SEED. HE FELT THAT THE LACK OF DISCIPLINE AND NEALERT WERE AT THE ROOT OF THE TROUBLE. THE TWIN PILLARS OF DISCIPLINE AND RELIGION WERE LOOMING LARGE IN HIS MIND.

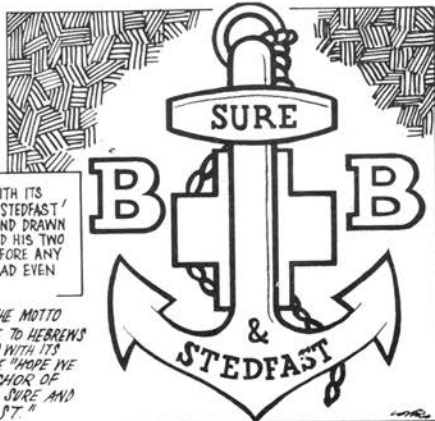


AT AN EARLY STAGE HE TOOK COUNSEL WITH JOHN B AND JAMES R HILL, WHO DESERVE WELL OF THE BOYS' BRIGADE AS SMITHS ORIGINAL LIEUTENANTS. MEETING IN AN UPPER ROOM OF A GLASGOW SUBURB, THE THREE MEN WORKED UNTIL THE EARLY HOURS, DRAWING UP THEIR PLANS. FIRST OBSTACLE TO BE CONSIDERED: THE TITLE OF THEIR NEW BODY: NO HESITATION HERE THE OBVIOUS NAME: **THE BOYS' BRIGADE.**

THE CREST WITH ITS MOTTO 'SURE AND STEDFAST' WAS ADOPTED AND DRAWN UP BY SMITH AND HIS TWO COLLEAGUES BEFORE ANY OF THE BOYS HAD EVEN MET.

SMITH TOOK THE MOTTO FROM THE EPISTLE TO HEBREWS (Chapter 6 Verse 19) WITH ITS REFERENCE TO THE 'HOPE WE HAVE AS AN ANCHOR OF THE SOUL, BOTH SURE AND STEDFAST.'

Smith had joined the Y.M.C.A. in Glasgow and had become an active Church worker at the Free College Church. In 1884 he married Amelia Pearson Sutherland. Gradually he became involved with the Boy for the first time in his life when he was introduced to the North Woodside Sunday School of which the Free College Church was the parent body. Having received the Queen's commission in the 1st Lanarkshire Rifles he soon realised the values of a soldiers disciplined life. He conquered the rough and tough Boys in the Sunday School but became distressed by number of Boys who slouched around in gangs on leaving the Sunday School. Together with John B. and James R. Hill, Smith worked ceaselessly in preparing plans for a new body to bring the Boys under its wing. So the formation of the Boys' Brigade took place in an upper room of a Glasgow suburb.

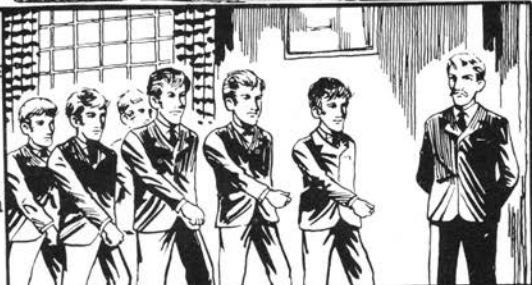
ON THE 4th OCTOBER 1883 AT THE NORTH WOODSIDE HALL-ON THE STROKE OF THE HOUR, THE DOORS WERE THROWN OPEN AND A DISORDERLY MASS OF JUVENILE HUMANITY SURGED IN. THE 1st GLASGOW COMPANY WAS AT LAST A REALITY.

BEFORE THEM STOOD THE "DAUNTLESS THREE", WILLIAM SMITH, JAMES HILL AND JOHN HILL, WITH A NEW LOOK IN THEIR EYES AND A NEW CONFIDENCE IN THEIR BEARING.



THE PIONEER IS ALWAYS A LITTLE BIT SUSPECT AND SMITH WAS NO EXCEPTION. EVEN HIS OWN MINISTER DR REITH TOOK TIME TO BE RECONCILED WITH THE TRAMP OF BOYS DRILLING ON THE SACRED FLOORS OF THE CHURCH PREMISES.

DRILL WAS ADOPTED BY SMITH AS THE BASIS OF HIS METHODS TO DEAL WITH THE UNRULY BOYS AND IT PROVED TO BE THE PERFECT CURE FOR SLOUCHING. HE WAS A MAN OF MILITARY STOCK AND IT WAS ONLY NATURAL THAT HE SHOULD TURN TO DRILL TO GIVE THE BOY SELF-CONTROL, MENTAL - CONCENTRATION AND SPIRITUAL UNITY THAT WAS LACKING IN THEIR LIVES.

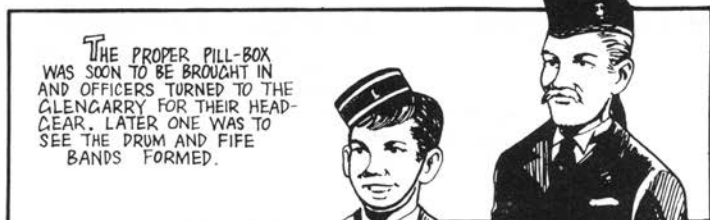
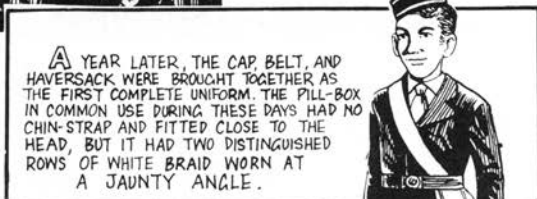


IN HIS EARLY PRINCIPLES SMITH LAID DOWN THE CLOSE UNION BETWEEN CHURCH AND COMPANY AND OFTEN INVITED BOYS, A SQUAD AT A TIME, TO HIS HOME FOR TEA AND A SOCIAL EVENING.



IN 1884, HE MARRIED AMELIA PEARSON SUTHERLAND, THE DAUGHTER OF A CARRISON CHAPLAIN, WHICH PROVED TO BE A PERFECT UNION AND PROVIDED HIM WITH HELP AND GUIDANCE IN HIS LIFE'S TASK.

On the 4th October 1883 at the North Woodside Hall the doors had been opened for the first time to a Boys' Brigade Company; the 1st Glasgow, formed by William Smith and assisted by his two lieutenants John and James Hill.

The start of a great organisation was in its infancy, guided by the high ideals of Smith who from the outset had laid down the twin pillars of Religion and Discipline as the foundation of the movement. A man of military tradition who turned to the qualities of drill as a basis to give his unruly Boys the spiritual control that was lacking in their lives. The uniform had progressed from a humble rosette to the familiar pill box cap, haversack and belt. The ground had been well prepared by the 'Dauntless Three' for the advance of the new body to take place.

FOR THE FIRST TWELVE MONTHS OR SO THE 1st GLASGOW COMPANY AT THE NORTH WOODSIDE MISSION HALL DWELT IN SPLENDID ISOLATION.



WHEN FIVE SIMILAR UNITS WERE IN BEING SMITH INVITED THE LEADERS TO MEET. IT WAS A HISTORIC MEETING, AND BY FORMAL RESOLUTION THEY CONSTITUTED THEMSELVES THE COUNCIL OF THE BOYS' BRIGADE.

THE EARLY COUNCIL PROVIDED THE MACHINERY FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE NEW MOVEMENT.

ONE OF THE FIRST CONDITIONS IT MADE WAS THAT EVERY COMPANY MUST HAVE A DEFINITE CHURCH CONNECTION.



THE NEXT FEW YEARS SAW THE ORGANISATION ADVANCE STEADILY AMONG THE EARLY LEADERS OF THE 1880'S. SEVERAL OF THEM WERE OUTSTANDING.

ONE SUCH MAN WAS CARFRAE ALSTON, WHO STARTED THE 4th GLASGOW AND WAS LATER ELECTED THE FIRST PRESIDENT OF THE BRIGADE, A POST HE HELD FOR 24 YRS.

NEW COMPANIES CONTINUED TO SPRING UP AS NEWS OF THIS NEW METHOD OF DEALING WITH BOYS SPREAD BEYOND THE CITY BOUNDS TO EDINBURGH.

AT THE END OF THE THIRD YEAR THE MOVEMENT NUMBERED 2,000 BOYS, MOSTLY IN SCOTLAND, CENTRED AROUND GLASGOW, WITH COMPANIES RANGED FROM AYR TO INVERNESS.

THEN A DEVELOPMENT OCCURRED WHICH WAS A LANDMARK IN B.B. HISTORY. THE MOVEMENT FILTRATED ACROSS THE TWEED AND THE ADVANCE CARRIED TO THE METROPOLIS, TO LONDON ITSELF. IN FACT TO WITHIN SIGHT OF LANDS END, WHERE THE 1st PENZANCE COMPANY RAISED THE B.B. FLAG.

THE FORMATION OF THE 1st LONDON COMPANY IS OF SPECIAL SIGNIFICANCE, STARTED BY A SCOTTISH FAMILY, NAMED ARTHUR, WHO WERE MEMBERS OF ST. JOHN'S WOOD PRESBYTERIAN CHURCH.

YET ALL WAS NOT PLAIN SAILING, THERE WAS CONSTANT OPPOSITION AND THE VOICE OF THE CRITIC WAS HEARD IN THE LAND. MANY BOYS WERE ROUGH AND UNRULY AND NOT AS CIVILISED AS BOYS OF TODAY, THIS HISTORIC DITTY WAS OFTEN DIRECTED AT NEWLY FORMED COMPANIES:—

'Here comes the Boys' Brigade  
All smothered in marmalade  
A tup'ny-apenny pill-box  
And arf a yard of braid.'

THE GLENCARRY CAP ATTRACTED THE SCORNFUL CRY OF 'SCOTCHIE! SCOTCHIE!' EVEN SOME DRILL PARADES WERE CONDUCTED UNDER A FUSILLADE OF STONES AND BRICKS THROWN UPON ROOFS AND THROUGH WINDOWS.

THE FOUNDER REMAINED CALM AND NEVER UTTERED A BITTER WORD AGAINST THE CRITICS.



AS THE MOVEMENT GREW BIGGER WILLIAM SMITH WAS STILL CARRYING ON HIS OWN BUSINESS AND IT WAS NOT UNTIL 1887 A YEAR MARKED BY QUEEN VICTORIA'S GOLDEN JUBILEE THAT ACTION WAS TAKEN.

THE BRIGADE PRESIDENT IN COUNSEL WITH OTHER LEADING FIGURES INVITED SMITH TO TAKE UP THE PART OF BRIGADE SECRETARY ON A FULL-TIME BASIS.

HE FELT IMPELLED TO SACRIFICE HIS BUSINESS CAREER IN FAVOUR OF THE **BOY.**



AN OFFICE WAS TAKEN IN BATH STREET IN GLASGOW AND WILLIAM SMITH BEGAN HIS DUTIES, TOO WILLING TO OVERWORK HIMSELF, BEYOND ALL LIMITS IN THE CAUSE OF THE MOVEMENT THAT HE HAD FOUNDED.

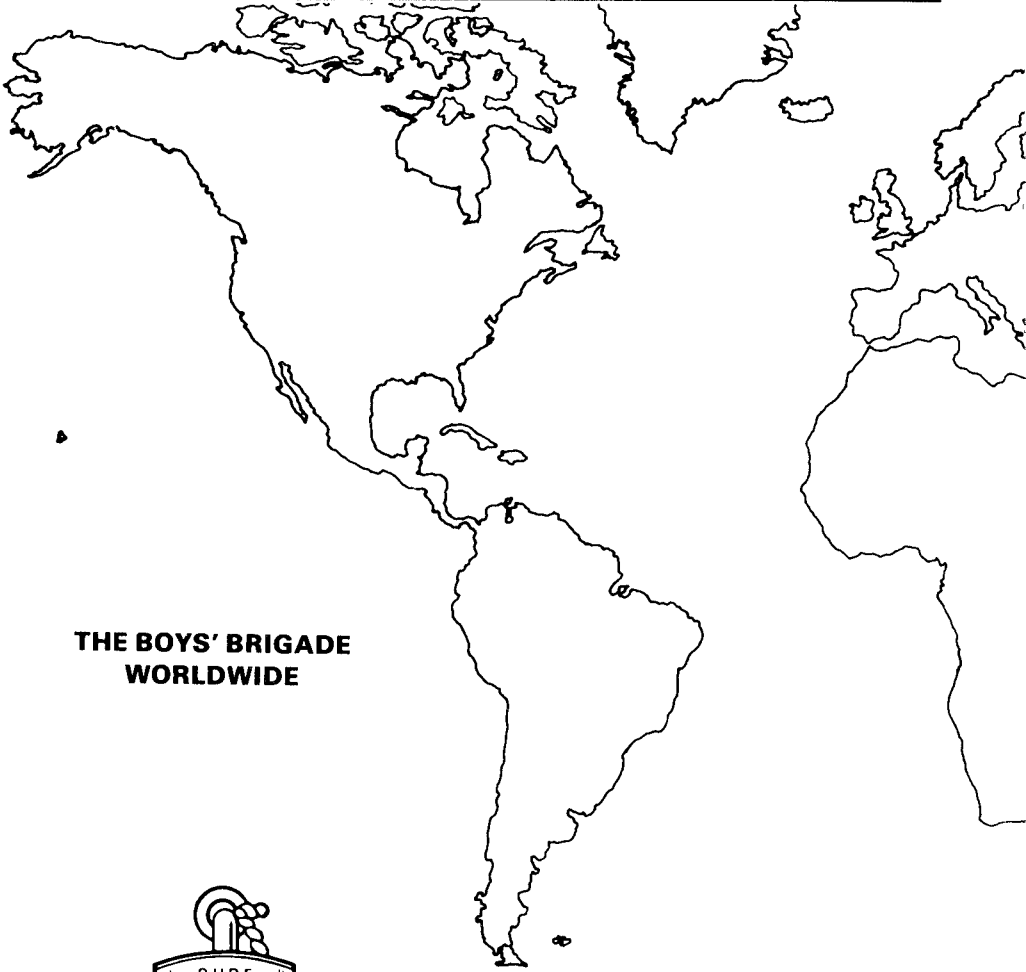

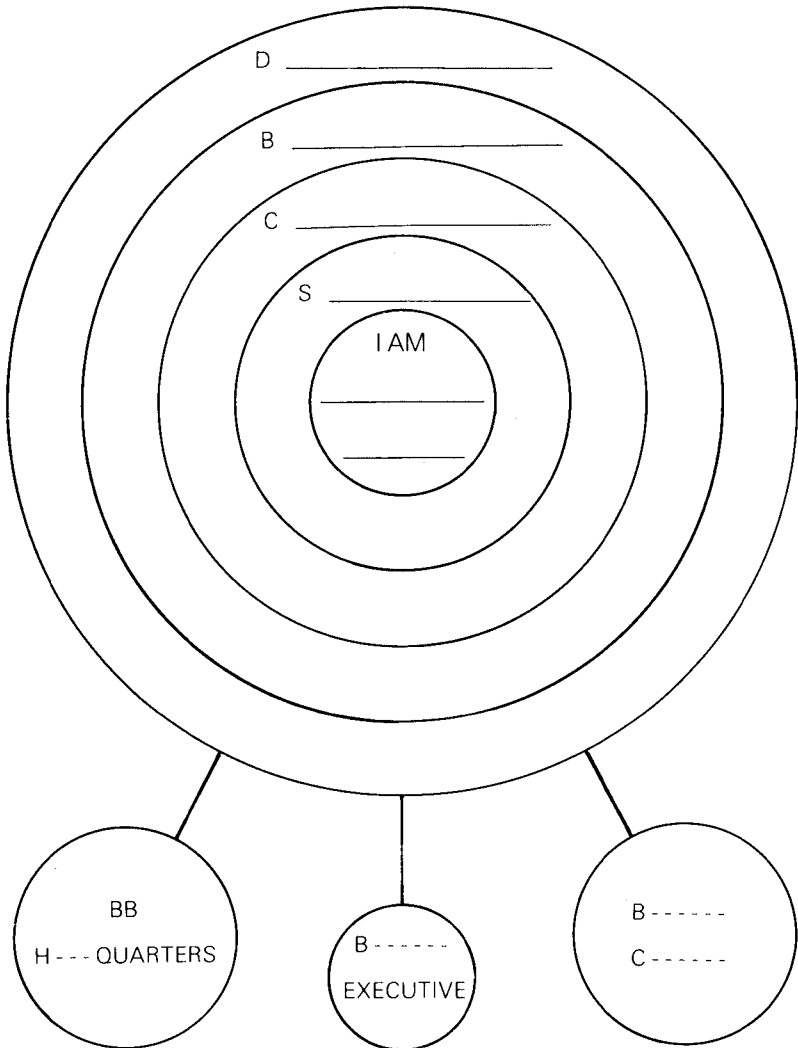

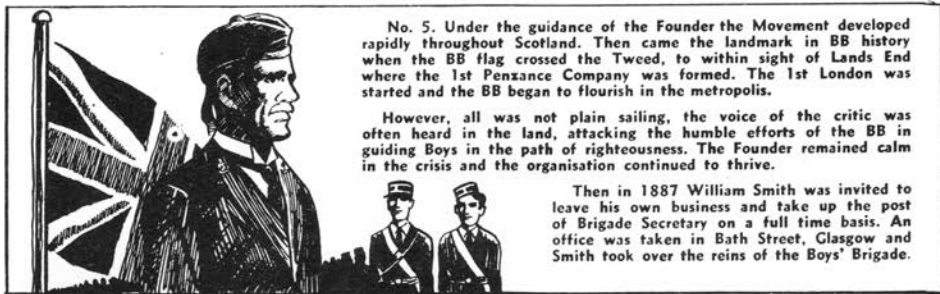

No. 5. Under the guidance of the Founder the Movement developed rapidly throughout Scotland. Then came the landmark in BB history when the BB flag crossed the Tweed, to within sight of Lands End where the 1st Penzance Company was formed. The 1st London was started and the BB began to flourish in the metropolis.

However, all was not plain sailing, the voice of the critic was often heard in the land, attacking the humble efforts of the BB in guiding Boys in the path of righteousness. The Founder remained calm in the crisis and the organisation continued to thrive.

Then in 1887 William Smith was invited to leave his own business and take up the post of Brigade Secretary on a full time basis. An office was taken in Bath Street, Glasgow and Smith took over the reins of the Boys' Brigade.

1. IN 1887 THE BB'S ADVANCE CROSSED THE SEA, WITH THE FORMING OF THE 1ST JERSEY. COMPANIES HAVE CARRIED ON IN THE CHANNEL ISLANDS EVER SINCE, EVEN DURING THE GERMAN OCCUPATION ONE GALLANT COMPANY PERSISTED IN UNDERGROUND EXISTENCE.



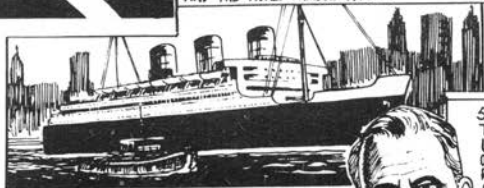
2. THEN IN 1888 - ACROSS THE IRISH SEA, WHERE THE 1ST BELFAST WAS FORMED. THE BEGINNING OF GREAT EVENTS IN A GREAT LAND, WHERE TODAY BELFAST PROUDLY POSSESSES THE SECOND LARGEST BATTALION IN THE BRIGADE.

COMPANIES CONTINUED TO FLOURISH THROUGHOUT THE WHOLE OF ULSTER AND IN 1890 SAW THE FORMATION OF THE 1ST DUBLIN, MARKING AN IMPORTANT POINT IN THE MOVEMENT'S GREAT ADVANCE.



3. SOON MISSIONARY COMPANIES DEVELOPED OVERSEAS, USUALLY AT ISOLATED STATIONS AND OUTPOSTS. PERHAPS THE MOST NOTABLE WAS THE GROWTH IN NIGERIA.

4. THE FOUNDER CONTINUED IN HIS FULL TIME CAPACITY AS BRIGADE SECRETARY, WORKING NON-STOP FOR THE MOVEMENT AND ON TWO OCCASIONS HE CROSSED THE ATLANTIC. THE FIRST TIME IN 1895 TO CANADA WHERE HIS TOUR ENDED WITH A VISIT TO THE 1ST NIAGARA COY AND THE WORLD FAMOUS FALLS.

5. TWELVE YEARS LATER THE FOUNDER VISITED THE U.S.A. AND THE HIGHLIGHT OF THE TOUR WAS A RECEPTION AT THE WHITE HOUSE WITH THE PRESIDENT THEODORE ROOSEVELT; A RELATIVE OF FRANKLIN ROOSEVELT WHO BECAME PRESIDENT OF THE U.S.A. LATER IN 1933



6. MANY BOYS IN MANY LANDS BEYOND THE SEAS HAVE REASON TO THANK GOD THAT THEY HAD THE OPPORTUNITY OF JOINING THE B.B. THE IDEA OF THE ADVANCEMENT OF CHRIST'S KINGDOM, WITH THE FOUNDER, KNEW NO BOUNDARIES OF RACE OR COLOUR.

7. THE B.B. BEING WELL ESTABLISHED IN SCOTLAND, SMITH TURNED HIS ATTENTION TO ITS DEVELOPMENT IN ENGLAND. HE BROUGHT MANY MEN OF AUTHORITY IN TO THE ORGANISATION TO GIVE POWER TO THE B.B.'S ADVANCE. THE OFFICE OF PATRON WAS LATER FILLED BY THE DUKE OF YORK, WHO WAS TO OCCUPY THE POSITION AS PRINCE AND KING FOR FORTY YEARS

\* \* \* \* \*

YET THROUGHOUT HIS LIFE THE FOUNDER RETAINED ACTIVE CAPTAINCY OF THE 1ST GLASGOW COMPANY AND NEVER WAS HE ABSENT FROM A PARADE OR BIBLE-CLASS EXCEPT FROM SHEER NECESSITY.



8. THE FIRST CAMP WAS HELD IN A SOUND AND WEATHERPROOF BUILDING AT TICHNABRUACH ON THE KYLES OF BUTE IN 1886. PUBLIC OPINION WAS AGAINST AT THE IDEA OF BOYS CAMPING OUT IN THE "WILDS"; SO THE FOUNDER DECIDED TO BOW TO THE CRITICISM AT THE FIRST CAMP AND TOOK REFUGE IN A BUILDING.



9. SMITH WAS AN EXPERIENCED YACHTSMAN AND FROM THE OUTSET THE FIRST CAMP MIGHT BE CALLED A SEA-FARING CAMP. EACH SQUAD HAD ITS OWN CRAFT AND IT WAS A SIGHT INDEED TO SEE THE BOATS BEING ROWED NAUTICAL ARRAY ON THE PLACID WATERS OF BUTE.



10. CAMPING SPREAD RAPIDLY, PREJUDICE DISAPPEARED AND CAMPING UNDER CANVAS SOON BECAME THE NORMAL ORDER OF THE DAY. B.B. CAMPING WAS SOON WELL ESTABLISHED AND IMMENSELY POPULAR AND LOOKED TO AS THE CROWNING OF THE COMPANY'S YEARS' WORK.

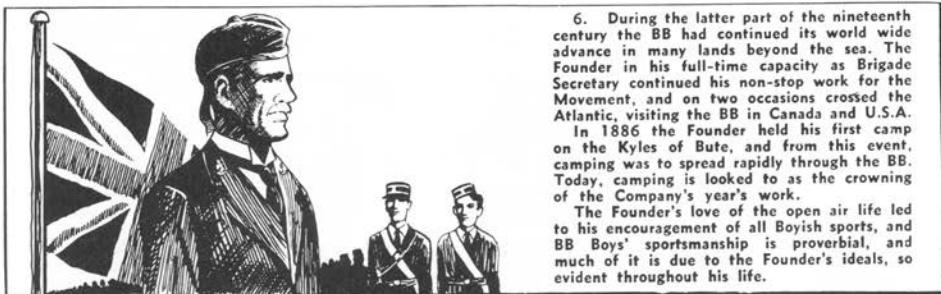


11. THE FOUNDER'S LOVE OF CAMPING AND HIS EARLY OPEN-AIR LIFE ON THE RUGGED CAUNTHESS COAST NATURALLY LED TO HIS SYMPATHY WITH ALL BOYISH SPORTS. FOOTBALL TOOK THE LEAD IN THE NORTH, FOLLOWED BY CRICKET AND ATHLETIC SPORTS

12. TODAY THE B.B. BOYS' SPORTSMANSHIP IS PROVERBIAL AND MUCH OF IT IS DUE TO THE FOUNDER'S IDEALS, SO EVIDENT THROUGHOUT HIS LIFE

6. During the latter part of the nineteenth century the BB had continued its world wide advance in many lands beyond the sea. The Founder in his full-time capacity as Brigade Secretary continued his non-stop work for the Movement, and on two occasions crossed the Atlantic, visiting the BB in Canada and U.S.A.

In 1886 the Founder held his first camp on the Kyles of Bute, and from this event, camping was to spread rapidly through the BB. Today, camping is looked to as the crowning of the Company's year's work.

The Founder's love of the open air life led to his encouragement of all Boyish sports, and BB Boys' sportsmanship is proverbial, and much of it is due to the Founder's ideals, so evident throughout his life.

1. THE NINETEENTH CENTURY WAS NOT TO PASS WITHOUT THE TRAGEDY OF THE BOER WAR AND THE ENDING OF QUEEN VICTORIA'S REIGN AFTER SIXTY-FOUR YEARS. THE B.B. NOW APPROACHING ITS TWENTIETH YEAR LOOKED FORWARD IN TO THE FUTURE WITH CLEAR EYES.



2. IN 1903 THE ANNUAL DISPLAY AT THE ROYAL ALBERT HALL WAS OF SPECIAL SIGNIFICANCE - FROM IT CAN BE TRACED THE VERY START OF THE BOY SCOUT MOVEMENT.



3. GENERAL BADEN-POWELL, BACK FROM HIS EXPLOITS IN MAKEKING, AGREED TO PRESIDE OVER THE FORTHCOMING DISPLAY AND SO BEGAN A SINCERE FRIENDSHIP WITH THE FOUNDER.



4. IN 1904, ONE YEAR LATER, BADEN-POWELL WAS AGAIN AT THE ROYAL ALBERT HALL DISPLAY. IT WAS THEN THAT HE REALISED WHAT A FINE THING IT WOULD BE TO TEACH ALL THESE BOYS THE ART OF SCOUTING. THE SEEDS OF THE SCOUT MOVEMENT HAD BEEN SOWN AND WERE SOON TO SPREAD LIKE A PRAIRIE FIRE.

BOTH BADEN-POWELL AND SMITH WERE GREAT LEADERS OF BOYS - THOUGH THEIR VIEWS DIFFERED WIDELY - THE FOUNDER OF THE B.B. STOOD FIRMLY WITH THE HIGH IDEALS THAT HE HAD SET.



5. IN 1909 THE FOUNDER'S NAME APPEARED ON THE HONOURS LIST. ### BB KNOWLEDGE — AWARD STRUCTURE

As you know, you must gain your Target Awards during your first Session in the Company Section. You will see from posters or from looking round the other Boys in the Company, or in other Companies, that there are plenty of awards to choose from. The reason for this is that the Brigade wishes to cover not only the subject which we think will be of great use to you in future years, but also subjects to enable you to develop your own particular interests. You should be able to gain a Credit for almost anything in which you are interested.

All the Credits are classified into 3 Grades. The particular Grade represents the amount of time you have spent studying the subject and the degree of skill or knowledge you have attained in it. Grade 1 is more or less your introduction to the subject, while Grade 3 shows you have gained insight and proficiency in it. You should aim to get as many Credits as possible.

No doubt it is your ambition to gain your President's badge and finally your Queen's Badge — the highest award in The Boys' Brigade. To do this you must show an all-round ability in BB work and gain all Badges, Red and Blue Surrounds as explained over the next few pages.

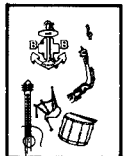
All Badges at Grade 3 are considered essential by the Brigade if you want to gain the two top awards. These are Brigade Leadership, Adventure, Community, Interests and Physical Badges with the Red (Grade 2) and Blue (Grade 3) Surrounds for each. Knowing this you should study hard to gain them all. They are not really difficult — none of the Credits are — provided you study and concentrate at your classwork.

Let us now look at the Awards and what you require to cover to gain your President's and Queen's Badges:

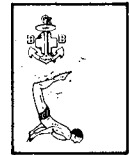
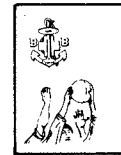
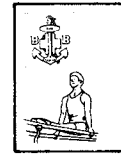
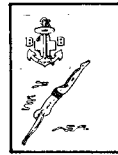
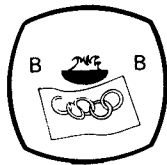
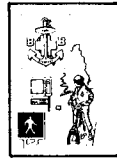
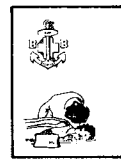
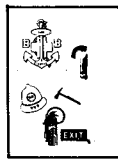
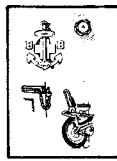
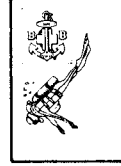
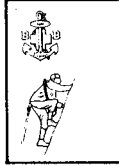
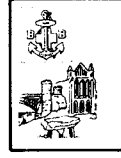
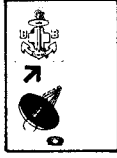
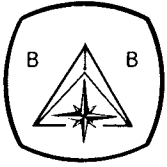

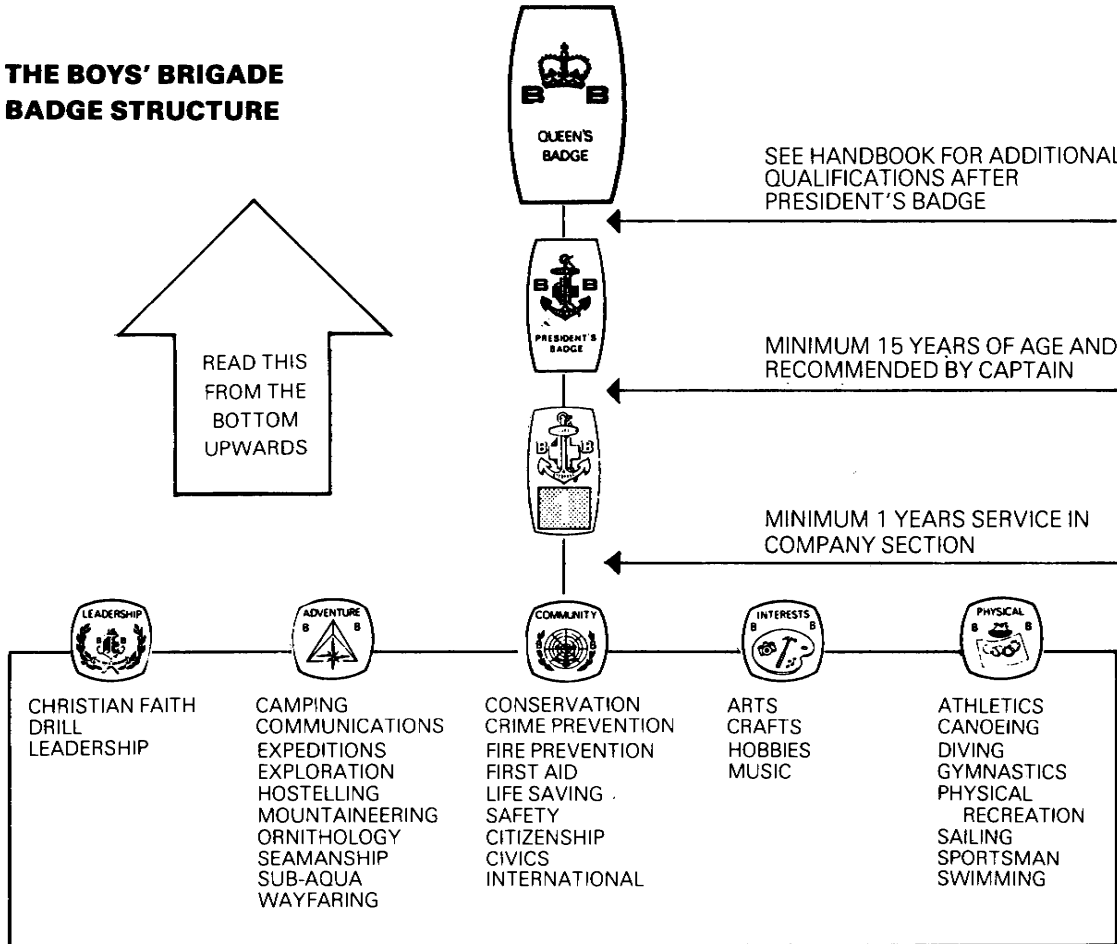
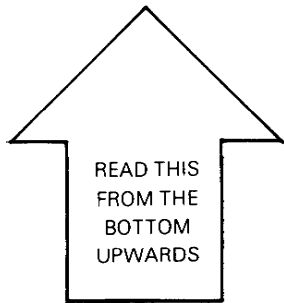
### QUEEN'S BADGE

This is the highest award that may be gained by a member of The Boys' Brigade and will be awarded to young men who qualify as follows:

1. Hold the President's Badge
2. Attend a Queen's Badge Conference as soon as possible gaining the President's badge.
3. Continue in membership of the Company for a further period of at least one year, during which time the young man must:—
  - (a) accept an appropriate degree of practical leadership as a junior member of staff in the Company and
  - (b) attend a Camp/Activity Holiday and participate in the planning and running of that event, or attend a Brigade Leadership Training Course.
4. Undergo appropriate briefing and then undertake at least 30 hours of practical service *outside the Company*.
5. Undertake an activity from one of the following three sections:
  - (a) Expedition
  - (b) Interests
  - (c) Physical Activity
6. The Company Captain must recommend him for the Award.
7. Attend satisfactorily a Queen's Badge Completion Course but not less than 12 months from the date of qualifying for the President's Badge.

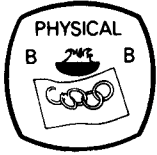

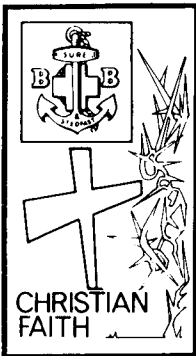

### THE DUKE OF EDINBURGH'S AWARD SCHEME

The Brigade has supported The Duke of Edinburgh's Award Scheme since it was first introduced and many, many Boys have proudly attended Buckingham Palace, or St James Palace, London or Holyrood Palace, Edinburgh, to be presented with their Certificates by Prince Philip himself. You can cover most of the requirements of the D of E Scheme by your normal BB Badge work, but when you reach Gold standard you will have to do additional tasks. You will have to apply for a Record Book when you intend starting in the Scheme.

By the time you become a Senior, (15 years of age) you will have gained most of the Awards you need and the BB tries to keep your interest alive by encouraging you to participate in the Seniors Programme. This offers a wide range of interests and activities including:

An Instructor's Certificate  
Leadership Training and Activities  
The Duke of Edinburgh's Award Scheme  
Activities of a sporting and educational nature.
